**Submission by Krasnoyarsk regional ecological public movement
«Friends of the Siberian Forest» on para 44 of the UNFF11 resolution.**

1. We fully support replacement of the reference to the Millennium Development Goals in paragraph 1 (b) of the non-legally binding instrument on all types of forests with an appropriate reference to the sustainable development goals and targets that were considered by the United Nations summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda that was held in New York in September 2015.
2. The strategic plan for the period 2017-2030 should consist from introduction, mission and vision, goals (including GOFs and SDG 15 with its targets) of the IAF.
3. In order to monitor achievement of goals and targets, IAF should use Criteria and Indicators (C&I) for sustainable forest management that were previously developed in many countries and regions. It would be useful to establish Global Forest Indicators Partnership for coordination this work and for Monitoring, Assessment and Reporting.
4. National reports on implementation of IAF should be regularly submitted to the UNFF Secretariat and they should be prepared by governments with involvement of Major Groups.
5. Quadrennial programme of work for the period 2017-2020, consistent with section XI of the UNFF11 resolution should be developed. AHEGs, CLIs and other meetings (including MGI before UNFF12) should help IAF implementation in national, regional and global levels.
6. Major Groups (MGs) will continue their important involvement in the implementation of IAF. Previously MGs organized 3 MGIs (before UNFF 9,10 and 11 sessions). And it would be important to organize another MGI (preferably in 2016) before UNFF12 session. It would be important to get support from UNFF Secretariat and donor countries.
7. Multi stakeholder dialogue will continue to be as a useful component for UNFF sessions. Also it would be useful to organize panel discussions and round tables during UNFF sessions with participation of representatives of MGs.

Dr. Andrey Laletin, FSF Chairman is nominated to participate in the AHEG-1 meeting in April 2016.
